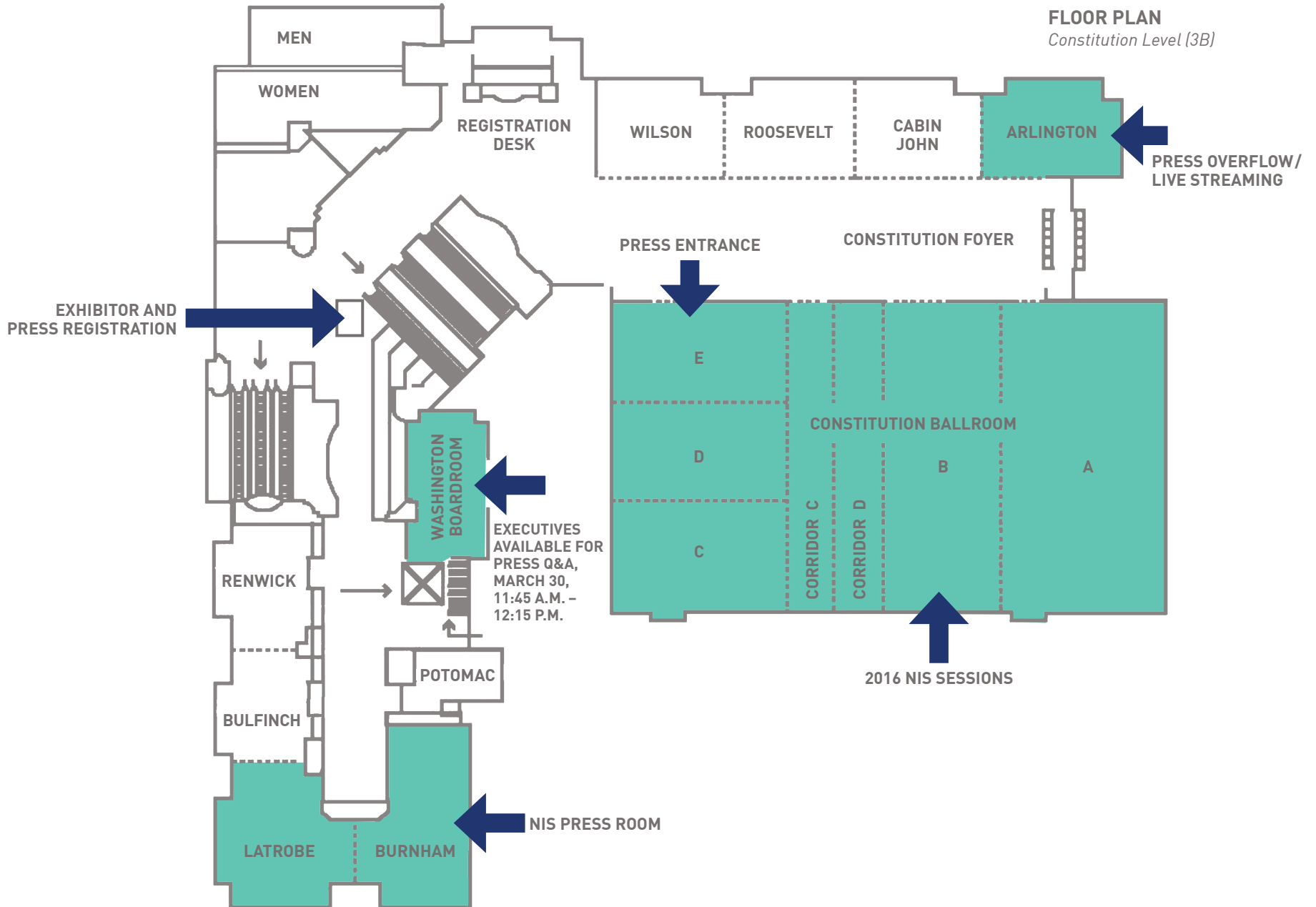

PRESS BADGES AND CREDENTIALS

- For safety reasons, please wear your NIS 2016 badge at all times while at the **Grand Hyatt Washington** (March 30-31) and remove your badge when leaving the Grand Hyatt.
- Separate credentials for the NIS awards luncheon (March 31) and the NIS 2016 Expo and Nuclear Security Summit (March 31-April 1) will be distributed at the **Walter E. Convention Center** at the press entrance near 9th and L Streets, NW. Credentials must be displayed at all times and also should not be worn when leaving the Walter E. Washington Convention Center.
- If you lose your badge for either venue, we **cannot** provide replacements. Do not share your badges for access to any events.

MEDIA ATTENDANCE AT EVENTS

- During all NIS 2016 events at the Grand Hyatt, the ballroom has limited seating for 50 members of the media and access is on a first come, first serve basis.
- We will live stream all of the events in the **Arlington Room** for anyone unable to gain entrance into the ballroom.
- There are three risers in the back of the **Constitution Ballroom** reserved for television crews.

PRESS ROOM

- The Nuclear Industry Summit Press Room is located in the **Latrobe and Burnham** rooms. The press room is equipped with electrical outlets, Internet access, tables and chairs. Because of potential space limitations, if there is a period when you are filing stories and do not need to view events inside the ballroom, you are requested to do so from the Latrobe and Burnham rooms to ensure sufficient space is available for other journalists in the Arlington Room.
- One-on-one camera/audio interview space with an NIS 2016 backdrop is available in the hallway near the **Press Registration desk**.
